Family Devotional

1 DESCRIPTION

In the days of the early church in Acts, we see that the priorities of believers shifted after they had been gifted with the Holy Spirit. Believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, to fellowship, to the breaking of bread together, and to prayer. These things characterized the believers of the earliest church and should characterize us today.

3. The early church redefined the win by caring for one another and living for the sake of spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ. What is your win?

3 ACTIVITY

Devote yourselves to the teaching of God's Word as you discuss what God is teaching you, and spend time praying together as a family that God would continue to help you be a disciple who makes disciples.
